



What may seem like a typical day at work may end up being life changing for the person who chose to come to the Y that day. The Angel Award was established to honor a YMCA staff person who exemplifies the values of the Y in every day work while making an extraordinary impact in the life of a member of our community.



On November 20, 2015, a member at the Briargate YMCA was found unresponsive in the pool by Y lifeguards and his children. The member was immediately pulled out of the pool and YMCA staff began performing CPR, utilizing the AED and providing oxygen once responsive. Upon arrival of emergency personnelle, the member was responsive and breathing on his own and was transported to a local hospital. The family of the member returned to the Y a couple days later to thank the Y staff and retrieve the members personal belongings. Family stated the Y member had a heart attack and doctors were able to treat him effectively because of the care he received at the Y.


